Instructions for Submitting Your <u>ESSAY</u> for the 18 Under 18 Application

The 18 Under 18 award honors young individuals who demonstrate outstanding character, leadership, and service. The essay component of the application provides an opportunity for the judges to gain a deeper understanding of your personality, values, and achievements.

Essay Requirements:

- 1. Essay Length: 500 words.
- 2. Topics to Address:
 - **Community Service:** Describe how you have positively impacted your community.
 - Work Ethic & History: Share examples of your dedication, hard work, and persistence in school, work, or personal projects.
 - **Leadership:** Highlight your leadership roles and how you have inspired others.
 - **Caring & Selflessness:** Discuss what you are passionate about and how you demonstrate care and compassion for others.
 - **Citizenship & Patriotism:** Provide examples of your patriotic actions and how you show pride in and contribute to your community or country.
 - **Personal Achievements:** Reflect on accomplishments that make you proud.
- 3. **Originality:** The essay must be written by you, the applicant. Essays written by someone else (e.g., parents, siblings, AI technology) will result in disqualification.
- 4. **Formatting:** Use clear, professional language. Essays should be typed Double-spaced and use a 12-point standard font.



ESSAY Rubric:

The essay serves to evaluate applicants for the 18 Under 18 award, focusing on their achievements, community impact, personal growth, and alignment with the values of the Exchange Club of Spencer.

3. Work Ethic & History	Mentions work ethic or history, but examples lack detail or connection to the topic.	Describes a solid work ethic with relevant examples of hard work and perseverance.	Provides strong evidence of dedication, persistence, and reliability in work, school, or personal projects. Offers clear examples of overcoming challenges or demonstrating initiative.
4. Leadership	Mentions leadership but lacks specific examples or depth.	Describes leadership roles with examples, though details may be limited. Shows evidence of influencing others positively.	Clearly outlines leadership roles, emphasizing the ability to inspire and guide others. Provides examples of successful outcomes or positive change.
6. Caring & Selflessness	Mentions caring or selflessness but does not provide specific examples.	Describes caring and selflessness with examples, though they may lack depth or impact.	Demonstrates consistent acts of kindness and selflessness with examples of how they have impacted others. Shows empathy and a commitment to helping others.
7. Citizenship & Patriotism	Mentions patriotism but does not provide specific examples or show a clear connection to their action.	Describes patriotism with relevant examples, though details may be limited.	Clearly articulates a sense of pride in and commitment to their community or country. Provides specific examples of actions or values that reflect patriotism.
8. Personal Achievement	Mentions achievements but lacks specific examples or detail about their significance.	Describes notable achievements with some detail, though the explanation may lack depth.	Highlights significant accomplishments with specific details about challenges overcome and lessons learned.



Congratulations on taking this step to apply for the **18 Under 18** program! Your video is a key part of your application, so here are some important instructions to help you create an impressive submission:

1. Length

• Your video should be no longer than **5 minutes**. Practice ahead of time to stay within this limit.

2. Dress to Impress

• Present yourself as if you are attending a job interview. Dressing professionally shows effort and respect for the process.

3. Speak Clearly and Slowly

• Ensure your voice is clear and your pace is steady. Speak loudly enough for reviewers to hear you easily and enunciate your words carefully.

4. Plan Ahead

Create a cheat sheet or outline to help you stay organized and on track. It's okay to use AI to help you gather your thoughts and it is acceptable to refer to your notes during the video if needed—just ensure they don't distract from your presentation.

5. Add Visual Interest

• Use **visual props** to make your video stand out. These can include items related to your community work, job responsibilities, or personal passions. Let your creativity shine!

6. Be Yourself

• Show your personality, energy, and enthusiasm. Reviewers want to get to know the real you, so don't be afraid to let your unique character and passions come through.

7. Have Fun

• This is your chance to shine and share your story! Enjoy the process and remember that this video is an opportunity to highlight everything that makes you a great candidate for this honor.

VIDEO Rubric:

This rubric provides a guide for students to assess their video presentation and ensures their application highlights key aspects of their achievements, character, and community involvement. Scores range from **1 point** to **5 points** for each criterion.

3. Work Ethic & History	Does not mention having a job or does not explain responsibilities clearly.	Describes a job or responsibilities but lacks detail about skills or contributions.	Provides a clear, detailed explanation of job history, responsibilities, and contributions to the workplace.
4. Leadership	Does not provide examples of leadership or gives vague examples.	Mentions leadership roles but does not elaborate on actions taken.	Describes leadership roles with specific examples of actions taken and the positive impact made.
6. Caring & Selflessness	Does not describe a specific instance of caring or selflessness.	Provides a general example of caring or selflessness with little detail.	Shares a compelling, specific story that demonstrates their care and selflessness toward others.
7. Citizenship & Patriotism	Does not provide examples of patriotism or citizenship.	Mentions patriotism or citizenship but lacks specific actions or context.	Offers a detailed and heartfelt example of participation in patriotic or civic activities.
8. Creativity	Video lacks creativity and engagement, with no use of props, visuals, or unique ideas.	Video includes some creative elements, such as props or visuals, but they are not fully integrated.	Video is highly creative, with engaging visuals, props, or unique ideas that enhance the storytelling and impact.
